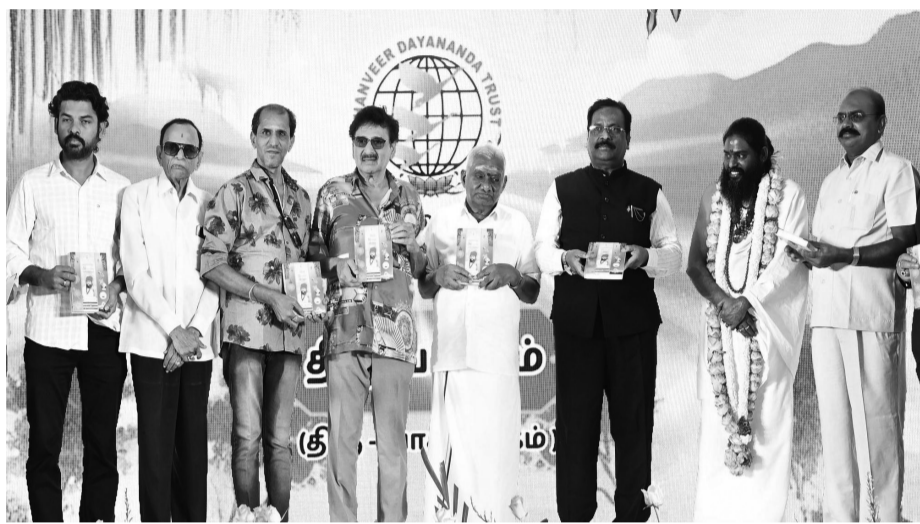
Spiritual book, CD launch mark Dhanveer Dayananda Jayanti
